he iniversity requires a parent or responsible person over the age of act as guarantor and sign the enancy Agree ent his eans that the guarantor ust pay any suits agreed under the enancy Agree ent if the student fails to do so

he Iniversity cannot assue parenta responsibility for a student under the age of tudents and their fall i les should bear in lind that the Iniversity is an adult environent tudents are expected to behave it eads to assue adult eves of responsibility

The University's responsibilities to students under the age of 18 years

The University will:

Offer acco odation to a those students who fu fi the criteria set out in a ocation po icy
Give priority choice of acco odation to students who qua ify for the guaranteed acco odation

House students in acco odation c ose to where there is easy access to a hour staffed reception faci ity – preferab y on the ca pus at which the student's course is based

A ocate students to sing e roo s rather than shared roo s, as a priority A ocate students in ensuite roo s rather than standard roo s, as a priority A ocate students catered faci ities rather than se f catered faci ities, as a priority

Integrate students who are under years of age with those who are over end docu entation, including a Licence Agree entiter is conditions, including catering ter is and conditions if required, to the student and guarantor that is required to be accepted signed and returned to the Acco odation Office by the guarantor before the student can talle up residence

Carry out regu ar DB chec s on staff who have one to one contact with under year o ds as part of their everyday duties, and routine y and regu ar y onitor the

Insist staff on y enter student bedroo s at a ocated ti es or fo owing roo entry procedures

Provide re evant training and guidance for acco odation staff e p oyed by the university, roo ey ho ders and staff with regular access to study bedroo s and e phasise that a of the have a responsibility to report concerns

Arrange a eeting within one onth of the start of the acade ic year with the Acco odation Manager or ine anager and encourage the student to attend he Acco odation Manager wi conduct the eeting to discuss the student's transition fro ho e ife to inversity acco odation and to chec on the student's genera we being

Arrange fo ow up eetings where requested by the student, but not otherwise

Pro pt y infor the person na ed as next of in on the student's acco odation application for if acco odation staff becore aware of and or are concerned about the student's health involve ent in an accident or serious breach of their accorodation agree ent including rent arrears. Provide counse ingland first aid, if requested to do so or if threatening first aid on y

Encourage staff in university anaged bars to chec proof or age in cases where they are not sure

reat sy pathetica y any requests for a change of roo within the \(\subseteq \) niversity acco odation a ways sub ect to avai abi ity and suitabi ity. No charge wi be ade for the roo change, if approved

Ensure that students are aware of who to contact in case of difficuties, and ensure that students have eans of ensuring confidentia ity where they wish it he involvesity wi try and encourage students to involve a parent where appropriate but we will take a student's request for confidentiality and the student's welfare as paramount, even if this means not telling their parent at the student's request.

a e serious y a suspicions and a egations of abuse and respond swift y and appropriately, following the University's U18 Policy. This could result in contact with official authorities e.g. police, social services etc.

Pay particu ar attention to training students in fire safety and evacuation procedures
